GAME RECAP – BOISE 10, SPOKANE 9: Jeimer Candelario hit a walk-off RBI double to right-center in the bottom of the ninth inning, lifting the Boise Hawks to a 10-9 victory over the Spokane Indians at Memorial Stadium. After the Indians rallied with six runs in the eighth inning and got an RBI double from Ryan Rua in the ninth to erase a 9-2 deficit, the Hawks quickly ended the game. Stephen Bruno lined a leadoff single off reliever Cody Kendall, with Candelario hitting a two-strike pitch off the wall in right, delivering Boise's fourth walkoff win of the season. The Hawks jumped out to a 9-1 lead after four innings, getting a three-run homer from Dan Vogelbach in a four-run third, and a two-run homer from Marco Hernandez in a four-run fourth inning. However, the Indians had seven-straight batters reach in the eighth inning rally to close the gap to 9-8. Spokane had the go-ahead run aboard with one out in the ninth, but Eddie Orozco struck out Joe Maloney and Preston Beck to end the threat. Candelario went 3-for-4 with three RBI, with Bruno adding a 3-for-5 night with two RBI in the win. Dong-Yub Kim and Trey Martin added two hits for the Hawks, who extended their win streak to a season-high four games. Royce Bollinger went 4-for-5 with two runs scored in the loss for Spokane, with Beck going 3-for-5 with a double, triple, and two RBI.

NOTES: The game-winner by Candelario was his second of the season, joining his walk-off homer vs. Yakima on July 16...Justin Amlung was solid in his Boise debut, going two shutout innings, allowing just one hit and striking out two...Felix Pena tossed five innings of two-run relief, allowing five hits, and fanning two...Matt Iannazzo struggled for a second-straight appearance, allowing six runs in a third of an inning, as his ERA ballooned to 21.21...the run scored by the Indians in the third ended the Hawks shutout streak at 25 2/3 innings...Hernandez's homer extended his hit streak to six...

ROSTER MOVES: Following the game, the Hawks made a pair of roster moves, as OF Izaak Garsez was activated from the 7-Day Disabled List, while RHP Roderik Pichardo was given his release by the Chicago Cubs.

ABOUT THE HAWKS STARTER: Jose Arias will make his tenth start of the season tonight for the Hawks, having posted a 2-2 record and a 3.21 ERA in 42 innings of work. The right-hander is coming off back-to-back losing efforts, despite tossing six-plus innings of three-hit ball on July 26 in a 1-0 setback against Yakima. Arias has faced Spokane twice, allowing six runs on 12 hits in 10 innings this season.

ABOUT THE INDIANS STARTER: Eric Brooks will make his ninth appearance and his eighth start of the season for the Indians, having posted a 2-1 record and a 2.52 ERA in 25 innings of work. The right-hander is coming off a win in relief against Tri-City, tossing four innings of four-hit ball, striking out four. Made two starts against Boise in June, tossing six-plus innings, allowing six runs on nine hits.
